All the **Colleges** in Pavia, with the exclusion of affiliated structures, are managed by a **Dean (Rettore)**, a university professor, who is often on the premises.

The management of the administrative and practical duties is carried out by a **Bursar** employed by EDiSU.

A range of general community services (**study halls, living rooms, libraries, sports facilities**) are also available and are designed to promote social interaction in everyday life within the residential unit.

All colleges offer bed linen, a **laundry service and weekly room cleaning**. All colleges provide a porter service, a reception desk and daily cleaning of the areas in common. A laundry service (washing and drying machines) is also available.

Canteen service in Pavia

Students attending courses in Pavia can benefit from meals in **canteens** managed by EDiSU at a cost which is based on their income tier.

Kitchens/kitchenettes are available in the colleges to allow students to prepare and consume their meals within the residential unit.



Prior enrolment at the University of Pavia for the academic year 2026/2027 **is NOT required** to apply for admission to the competition, however all enrolment procedures must **be completed by October 31, 2026**, except for the students enrolled in the “filter semester” of a Medicine and Surgery course or Dentistry and Dental Prosthodontics course.

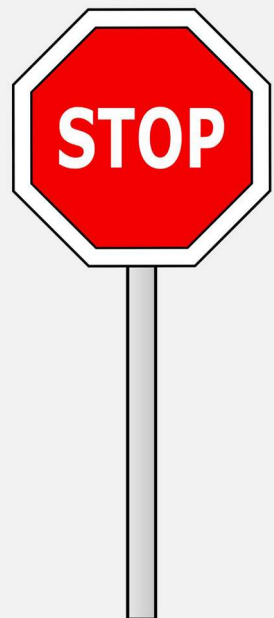
WHO'S NOT CONSIDERED ELIGIBLE?

➡ Student who's *above 32 years old*

➡ Students who *hold a degree of the same level as, or superior to*, the one for which the scholarship is being requested for the 2026/2027 academic year;

Example: In 2023/2024 I achieved a Bachelor Degree in Philosophy, in 2026/2027 I decide to enrol in another Bachelor Degree course, for example Economics -> in this case I cannot be eligible for the college placement since I already hold a degree of the same level

➡ Students who *DO NOT meet* the *merit-based requirements* prescribed by the call for application



GENERAL COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS



Italian and foreign students (*under 32 years old*) who declare to be enrolled, for the 2026/2027 academic year, at the University of Pavia/Istituto di Alta Formazione Artistica e Musicale “Franco Vittadini” of Pavia, by October 31, 2026:

- *For the first time*, in the first year of a bachelor's degree, master's degree or a single cycle master's degree
- *In the “filter semester”* of Medicine and Surgery course or Dentistry and Dental Prosthodontics course having chosen the University of Pavia as first location to continue the course of study.
- *In an extra year* (i.e., one year beyond the course's prescribed length) of a bachelor's degree, master's degree or a single cycle master's degree programme (1° year «fuori corso»);
- In a *specialization course* (with the exception of those pertaining to the field of medicine as defined by Legislative Decree 368/99);
- In a *PhD programme*



The competition is also open to *students with disabilities* – *students with recognized disabilities* (as defined by the law n. 104 dated February 5th, 1993, art. 3. 1 (e) 3) or whose level of *disability is 66% or higher* – who are enrolled for a further 2 years beyond the regular duration of their course of any bachelor's degree, master's degree or a single cycle master's degree programme.

All students, in order to be ELIGIBLE, need to meet the *merit-based requirements* listed later.

NB: students included in the ranking lists as ELIGIBLE for admission to college DO NOT AUTOMATICALLY GAIN A PLACE IN COLLEGE.

Eligible status on the ranking list indicates that the applicant is eligible but may be allocated a place, depending on availability



Students who meet the merit and income requirements will be placed on the “PRIMARY” RANKING LIST (access at discounted rates).

Students who meet the merit requirements but not the income requirements will be placed on the “SUPPLEMENTARY” RANKING (access at full rate) which is used **ONLY AFTER** placements have been allocated to those in the primary ranking.

MERIT-BASED REQUIREMENTS: STEADINESS IN ACADEMIC PROGRESS

In order to be ELIGIBLE to apply students must have completed their academic course REGULARLY, without any interruption or break in studies, in line with the standard annual progression points.



Students who in the 2026/2027 a.y. fall in one of the following categories **ARE THEREFORE EXCLUDED** from the ranking lists:

1. those enrolling after having previously withdrawn from a course of study (at the University of Pavia or another Italian/foreign university) prior to the 2026/2027 academic year;
2. those who are enrolled as “repeating students” in intermediate years;
3. those who are transferring to a different degree course, or who are transferring from another university, and they’re going to repeat a year of course already attended (at the University of Pavia or another Italian/foreign university);

BUT THERE’S AN EXCEPTION



Is eligible the student who has repeated a year of course, even after renewing the enrolment following formal withdrawal from a course, but has anyway completed the number of CFU required to access the ranking list according to attachment A (CFU recognized for the course of study in which the student intends to enrol for the a.y. 2026-2027).

The calculation of the minimum number of CFU, required for eligibility, is calculated starting from the year of absolute enrolment. This waiver **DOES NOT APPLY** to students enrolled in the 1st year of any degree course or to those enrolled in any year of a PhD programme or specialisation course.

EX: in 2024/2025 the student attends the 1° year of a three-year bachelor’s course in Biological Sciences. In 2025/2026, after withdrawing from the Biological Sciences course, he enrolls in the 1° year of the Geological Sciences course. If this student requests, in 2026/2027, the scholarship as a student intending to enroll in the 2° year of Geological Sciences bachelor’s degree, he will be eligible for the assignment of the benefit only if he has completed the number of CFU required for students who are enrolling in the 3° year of Geological Sciences, by August 10, 2026.

WHAT'S THE YEAR OF ABSOLUTE ENROLMENT?



The sentence “absolute enrolment” refers to the first year of enrolment in any bachelor degree course (even if different from the one attended in the current academic year) at any Italian or Foreign University, that has required the same qualifications as those required for enrolment in the course attended in the current academic year, regardless of the results of the previous course (withdrawal from the course, university transfer, graduation, etc.) *and the number of years that have elapsed since.*

Example: in 2024/2025 the student attends the first year of a bachelor’s course at Milan University. In 2026/2027, after withdrawing Milan from his 2nd year, the student enrolls in the regular first year of a bachelor’s course at Pavia University. If this student requests, in 2026/2027, EDiSU benefits he needs to indicate as **ABSOLUTE ENROLLMENT** the a.y. **2024/2025** (so the 26/27 a.y. would be his 3rd year).

MERIT-BASED REQUIREMENTS FOR NON-FIRST-YEAR STUDENTS



Students enrolled in a *bachelor's degree, master's degree or a single cycle master's degree programme*: to have completed, by August 10th, 2026, any *compulsory credits required* at the time of admission to their course and to have completed the *number of credits* prescribed by their most recently approved study plan (a.y. 2025/2026), as illustrated in *Attachment A*

CFU EXCLUDED

- credits earned by passing courses/exams that are **ADDITIONAL OR ELECTIVE** in the most recently approved study plan (a.y. 2025/2026)
- credits gained as a result of **TRANSFER/COURSE CHANGE**, with renewal of enrolment in a course year already attended, or credits gained from **SINGLE COURSES** taken in the previous academic year;
- the result of any **INDIVIDUAL EXAMS**, from integrated courses which contain a number of modules, which have not been registered in the "Student Booklet"



PhD students and students enrolled in specialization courses (except for those pertaining to the medical field): *meet the requirements* established by the University *to be able to enroll* in the following academic year.

PROPORTIONAL CRITERION

If the course of study, chosen by the student, *has a total number of credits which is fewer than 60*, the **merit requirements** listed in attachment A **are redefined in proportion** to the total possible number of achievable CFU.

We consider valid also:

- the results of final exams of **INTERNSHIP PROGRAMMES IN THE FIELDS OF MEDICINE, PHARMACY, AND PSYCHOLOGY** carried out after August 10, 2026, as long as the results are registered **by October 31 2026**.
- the exam results of *Fisiologia, Anatomia, Biochimica* (for students enrolled in "Medicina e Chirurgia"), *Living Molecules, Structure of the Body and Functions of the body* (for students enrolled in Medicine and Surgery in English), *Metodologia della Ricerca* (for students enrolled in Nursing and Midwifery Sciences), even if they are carried out after August 10th, 2026, but ONLY if the exam results are registered **by September 30, 2026**.

SUBS. YEARS

Students enrolled in further years (**not first-year students**) of a bachelor's degree, master's degree or a single cycle master's degree course can avail themselves of a **bonus ("crediti bonus")** which can be used to make up the difference between the minimum CFU required to enter the competition and the actual number of completed CFU.

if requested for the first time **in the second year** of the academic programme (ex: 2° year of a Bachelor Degree or Master's single cycle degree course)

if requested for the first time **in the third year** of the academic programme (ex: 3° year of a Bachelor Degree or Master's single cycle degree course)

if requested for the first time in **the years subsequent to the third year** of the academic programme (ex: 2° year Master degree*, from 4° year of a Master's single cycle degree, 1° year over time of BA, Master or Master's single cycle degree)

N.B.

Example

A student, enrolled in the 2024/2025 a.y. for the first time in a Master's single cycle degree course, in the 2026/2027 a.y. applies for a college placement as student enrolling in the third year. He has only 75 CFU and decides, for the first time in his university career, to use the bonus point to achieve the minimum CFU required which are 80.

His bonus credits are 12. In the 2026/2027 a.y. the student will use only 5 of his bonus CFU.

The 7 remaining bonus CFU can be used in subsequent years. ("the bonus package" has been «opened» in the year in which contains 12 CFU; they can all be used in one academic year or, if just some of them have been used, the remaining ones can be used in subsequent years.

The number of bonus points that the student can use during his entire academic career will correspond to the *number of bonus points contained in the package when was first opened.*

That's because, once the package is opened, it cannot accumulate additional bonus points).

→ The request of possible «use» of the bonus package must be done during the online application (there's a paragraph asking if you want to use the bonus points and you must tick yes).

→ If you reach the required CFU by yourself then the bonus point will not be used, even if you've previously ticked yes in the online application.

→ "Bonus credits" accrued and not used in the bachelor's degree course may be used if the student enrolls in a master's degree course.

→ "Bonus credits" which are not used in the academic year in which the student first requests their use may be used in subsequent years.

* Students enrolled in a master's degree course and holding a bachelor's **degree NOT obtained in Italy**, begin to earn bonus points only from their first enrolment in a master's degree course in Italy.

Bonus points **cannot be used** by **first year students** to meet the merit requirements.

INCOME-BASED REQUIREMENTS

 **ISEE UNI 2026 $\leq$ € 26.887,93**

an equivalent financial situation indicator issued for assessing access to services and benefits made available to support the right to higher education (ISEE UNI)

 **ISPE UNI 2026 $\leq$ € 58.452,06**

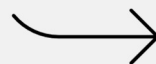
an equivalent asset situation indicator (ISPE = ISP of the family unit $\div$ equivalence scale coefficient)

Both must be fulfilled: if even one of these indicators exceeds, applicants do not meet the income-based requirements!



STUDENTS WITH INCOME AND ASSETS IN ITALY

These values are indicated in the **ISEE UNI 2026** statement that is issued by the INPS within 7-10 business days following submission of the **DSU (Dichiarazione Sostitutiva Unica)**



Italian or foreign students residing in Italy, with income and assets in Italy, must apply directly to **INPS** or through a **CAF**



Deadline to apply to INPS:

August 4, 2026



EDiSU **WILL NOT CONSIDER VALID** any indicators referring to the ordinary ISEE or statements that contain **notes referring to missing data or any discrepancies** detected by INPS.



STUDENTS WITH INCOME AND ASSETS IN ITALY

EDiSU, as authorized by the applicant when completing the online application, will retrieve from the **ISEE database of INPS**, the latest **ISEE UNI 2026 Certificate** issued in the name of the student requesting the benefit (research carried out based on the Tax Code of the student) and requested **no later than August 4, 2026.**

The data on income and assets used for the DSU and the **2026 ISEE UNI statement** refer to the **two previous calendar years** (therefore 2024 for the ISEE UNI 2026 Statement).

In some situations, in the presence of adverse events (for example, the loss of a job, the interruption of social security payment, welfare and indemnity treatment) or a significant variation in the income of the household, this income may **not reflect the real economic situation of the family unit.** The possibility to submit a **CURRENT ISEE by and no later than August 4, 2026** is therefore given.

The **CURRENT ISEE** is calculated on the income of the last twelve months and is valid for six months from the moment of presentation.

It is responsibility of the student to verify that the ISEE UNI 2026 statement, submitted to EDiSU:

- contains the value of the **indicator for assisted benefits to support the right to higher education** (ISEE UNI) or is a **CURRENT ISEE**.
- **does not contain notices** referring to missing data or any discrepancies detected by INPS

Students with **non-compliant ISEE indicators** will be put in the **SUPPLEMENTARY ranking list** unless they request (within the deadline established for the appeal -> **3 days from the publication of the provisional ranking list**) the issuance of a **new ISEE 2026 Attestation** for the right to university study that is in compliance with the regulations.



THE STUDENT'S FAMILY UNIT

IF THE STUDENT RESIDES WITH THE FAMILY

The family unit of the student attending university whilst residing with his/her parents, is the one made up of those members registered in the civil registry, as shown on the Family Status certificate.



If the student does not live with his/her parents but is not “independent”, he/she must be considered a member of his/her parents’ family unit.



INDEPENDENT STUDENT

- ✓ **Requirement 1:** The student **has been domiciled**, as registered in the civil registry, away from the parental household for a period of at least two years prior to the date of submission of the application and has been residing in accommodation which is not owned by a member of his/her original family unit;
- ✓ **Requirement 2:** The student has personal income deriving from employment or similar, provided that the student is not employed by a family member, and that income has been declared to the tax office for **at least the past two years** and amounts to **AT LEAST €9,000.00 per annum***.

FAMILY UNIT OF THE PHD STUDENT



- ❖ Is composed by the applicant himself/herself, his/her spouse, minor and adult children, if dependent and even if not cohabiting (“restricted nucleus”, with no other persons cohabiting)

Or, if more favourable,

- ❖ Is composed by all persons present in the family status on the date of submission of the Dichiarazione Sostitutiva Unica.

*If both conditions are **NOT SATISFIED** and not duly documented for all the years of reference at the time of application to EDiSU, the student **cannot be considered independent** and will **be included in the supplementary** ranking list unless he requests, within the deadline for submitting revision requests, the issue of a new ISEE 2026 for the right to university study in which he is treated as a member of his original family unit.*

*The status of independent student is also applicable to **legally married students** or students in a “**de facto state of cohabitation**” registered at the Municipality of residence. In this case the minimum income of € 9,000.00 refers to the total income, **including that of the spouse/de facto cohabitant**.



INCOME-BASED REQUIREMENTS

STUDENTS WITH INCOME AND ASSETS OVERSEAS

The financial status of foreign students whose family unit resides abroad or of Italian students residing abroad is determined by the Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator abroad statement (**ISEE parificato**) calculated as:

OVERSEAS INCOME of each member of the family unit



20% OF THE ASSETS (movable and non-movable) owned by each component



The abovementioned documents **must be** issued by competent Authorities in the country in which the income was made and in which any buildings and financial assets are owned, **LEGALISED** by the Italian Diplomatic Authorities acting in that country, together with an **ITALIAN TRANSLATION CERTIFIED** by the same Authorities. For countries that are members of the Hague Convention, authentication can be performed by using an **APOSTILLE**.

The result of this sum is **DIVIDED BY THE EQUIVALENCE SCALE COEFFICIENT** determined by the number of members of the family unit of reference.

NB: Photocopied documents will **NOT** be accepted/evaluated.

So, if your family has income and assets abroad, you must submit to EDiSU original hard copy documents* stating:

*This applies even if you don't live in the same household as your parents residing abroad, but you can't be considered "independent" yet.

1) the composition of the **family unit**, including the student, other family members and any person officially residing with the family unit (indicating date of birth and the nature of the relationship)

2) the gross income received abroad in **2025**, or an unemployment statement referring to 2024

3) the number of any buildings owned abroad as of **December 31, 2025**, including surface measurement in **square meters**, or a document stating that no one owns a property

4) the amount of any movable assets (bank balance, shares, bonds...) as of **December 31, 2025**

for each adult member of the family unit



STUDENTS WITH INCOME AND ASSETS OVERSEAS

For those countries where it is particularly difficult to have documents certified by a local Italian Embassy, *as an alternative* an **original certification of income and assets** owned can be submitted, in the Italian language, by the diplomatic or consular representation in Italy of the foreign country.

The certification issued by the diplomatic or consular representation in Italy must be **LEGALISED BY A PREFECTURE** and must expressly refer to the documents originally issued in the country of origin.

For foreign students coming from particularly **POOR COUNTRIES** the evaluation of their financial status is based on a ***statement issued by an Italian consular agent*** in the country of origin, or by ***Diplomatic Authorities*** of the country of origin in Italy, certifying that the student does not belong to a family with known high income and social status.

Students holding the ***status of stateless person or political refugee*** or holders of subsidiary or ***special protection*** are treated as Italian citizens and, for the purpose of evaluating their financial condition, **are exempt from submitting statements issued by Embassies and Consulates**, because the only elements that will be considered are any income and assets possessed in Italy, which must be certified in the same manner as for Italian students (ISEE UNI statement).

The stateless person/political refugee/holder of subsidiary or special protection status must be substantiated by evidence provided by applicants through official documents, in date and valid. These documents must be attached (uploaded) in electronic document format to the online application and later handed in at the EDiSU help desk.

NB. For the **submission of foreign documents** it is only possible to access the EDiSU counters by **APPOINTMENT** (by **opening a new "Appointment SRM"** in your personal area of EDiSU)

Failure to submit these documents to EDiSU within August 4 (in original hard copy), implies that the student is included in the **SUPPLEMENTARY ranking list** for the college placement



STUDENTS WITH INCOME AND ASSETS OVERSEAS

Any income made abroad and declared by foreign students **must amount to NO LESS than € 10.179,85** (the annual social allowance amount) which is the established minimum amount required for supporting oneself.

In **NO CASE** whatsoever will any form of self-certification, substitute statement, affidavit or sworn declaration referring to income and/or assets abroad **be accepted**. If any of these types of documents are submitted, they will **NOT BE TAKEN INTO CONSIDERATION**.

→ Foreign students **residing with their families in Italy**, *with no income or assets abroad*, are only required to submit the ISEE UNI 2026 certificate.

→ Foreign students whose immediate **family unit is wholly or partly abroad** and who also have income and/or assets in Italy (even if they only have a bank account in Italy) are also required to present, in addition to the original foreign documentation, **the ISEE UNI 2026** and are obliged to declare any income and assets held in Italy through an ISEE UNI statement.

→ If the student does not live in the same household as their parents residing abroad but is not “independent”, he will be considered as a member of their parents' household and must therefore present foreign documentation related to their household.

Application is to **BE SUBMITTED ONLINE ONLY**.
CONFIRMATION of the online application must be made no later than *August 4, at 3 pm*.

After confirming the online application, foreign students whose family unit resides abroad and Italian students residing abroad, **MUST UPLOAD** in **electronic file** format copies of all the documents required (section “Upload documents” - “foreign documentation” in the “Student online services” area of EDiSU website).

ORIGINAL HARD COPIES of the same documents must be submitted to EDiSU by and not later than *August 4, at 3 pm* either **in person** to the office counter (Via Calatafimi, 11) or sent by **postal service** (Via San't Ennodio, 26, 27100 Pavia).
FAILURE TO SUBMIT the ORIGINAL HARD COPIES of all the certifications shall result in *in the inclusion in the* **SUPPLEMENTARY RANKING LIST**.

PROCEDURE BY WHICH RANKING LISTS ARE FORMED

STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE FIRST YEAR

is based on the **ISEE UNI 2026 statement** referring to the student's family unit scaled to the ISEE limit of € 26.887,93



Maximum of 1000 points

STUDENTS ENROLLED IN SUBSEQUENT YEARS

Positioning in the ranking list depends on the total score resulting from the sum of

the score based on the **number of credits** achieved by August 10th, 2025, (~~maximum 600 points~~)



the score determined by the **average mark (weighted average)** of the student's exams passed (~~maximum 400 points~~)

Maximum of 1000 points

It is responsibility of the student: A) to ascertain that his Booklet contains **records of every exam the student has passed** (those included in the most recently approved study plan) B) to notify EDiSU, when the provisional ranking list is issued, if there are **any missing records** or cases of "pending approval".

Positioning within the ranking list depends on the score attributed to the applicant, shown from the highest to the lowest and determined by **income or merit criteria**. Scores being equal, it precedes the student enrolled in a higher-level course, in the more advanced year of course. In case there is still a tie, the final mark of the applicant's high school qualification will be considered, and finally the applicant's age, with the younger applicant being ranked higher.

Students with disabilities, having a level of disability of or above 66%, take precedence over other candidates in the assignment of college placements and particularly, upon request, at the "Collegio Volta" and "Collegio del Maino", where adequately equipped rooms are available.

To the score obtained in application previous criteria (maximum 1.000 points) will be added a further score, with maximum 2.000 points, awarded according to the type of student

STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE FIRST YEAR

★ A maximum of 1000 points based on the mark obtained on diploma or degree required by the course that the student intends to study in the 2026/2027 academic year (e.g., High school diploma for bachelor's or single cycle master's degree course)

★ A maximum of 1000 points assigned by the Dean and based on the questionnaire and interview, if required.

STUDENTS ENROLLED IN SECOND OR A SUBSEQUENT YEAR

★ A maximum of 1000 points based on the ISEE UNI 2026 value

★ A maximum of 1000 points assigned by the Dean and based on the questionnaire and interview, if required.

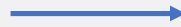
Students who **DO NOT SEND IN THE QUESTIONNAIRE BY THE DEADLINE** or who fail to attend an interview will **NOT be admitted** to Cairoli college or Volta college.

This does not imply exclusion from a place at other colleges.

Any students in the ranking list to access the Cairoli College or the Volta College and no longer assignable to these facilities due to exhaustion of places, may be assigned to other colleges based on the scrolling of the ranking lists

RANKING LISTS PUBLICATION

The **PROVISIONAL**, “PRIMARY” and “SUPPLEMENTARY”, **RANKING LISTS** (divided between placements in Pavia and placements in Cremona, and also between “Italian/EU-students” and “non-EU students”) will be made public by **AUGUST 28, 2026**.



Any **request to review** the provisional ranking lists must be submitted to EDiSU in the “Online Student Services” area **no later than 3 days** following publication of the ranking lists.

EDiSU website -> Online students services -> Upshot Ranking -> provisional ranking list -> **BUTTON «istanza di revisione** – review request» at the end of the page

Students who, in the provisional ranking, were excluded as the result of a **non-compliant ISEE 2026** **don't need to submit a request for review** but must request **no later than 3 days** from the publication of the provisional rankings, the release of a **new ISEE 2026 certification** for the right to university study, compliant to the regulations.

Students with **incomplete foreign documentation** may complete it submitting to EDiSU, by the deadline for submitting requests for revision, the missing documentation.

The **outcome of the review** will be announced to the student directly in the “Online Student Services area / Ranking results” section and, **if accepted**, will produce effects in the final ranking.



The **DEFINITIVE RANKING LIST** will be made public by **SEPTEMBER 3, 2026**

CRITERIA BY WHICH COLLEGE PLACEMENTS ARE ASSIGNED AND HOW TO ACCEPT

PLACEMENTS WILL BE ASSIGNED starting **SEPTEMBER 7, 2026**.

Entry into the college (for “**new entry**” students) will take place starting from September 14, 2026, and in any case subject to agreement with the Bursar of the College.

Students deemed eligible to access the EDiSU colleges and automatically assigned to one of the colleges will receive a **written communication confirming their admission** and the name of the college they have been assigned to.

The student will be given a **deadline of two (2) days** by which he will have to send a written statement declaring:

For **ALL STUDENTS** (except for the following specific cases)

- ★ Acceptance of the bed spot for the entire academic year in the college to which he has been assigned to.
- ★ The payment receipt, made through PagoPA, of the confirmatory deposit **250,00€**.
- ★ Acceptance of the college rules of conduct.

Failure to accept the spot and to provide proof of **the 250,00€ fee payment**, within the given deadline, **represents**, to all intents and purposes, **a formal renunciation** of placement in any EDiSU college.

For all students enrolled in the **FIRST YEAR** of a degree course with **RESTRICTED ACCESS** and with a selection at a national/local level, whose **RESULTS ARE NOT PUBLISHED YET**

- ★ Acceptance of bed spot, for the entire academic year, in the college to which he is assigned.
- ★ Acceptance of the college rules of conduct.

These students **DON'T NEED TO PAY** the deposit fee at the time they accept the spot.

Failure to accept the spot within the given deadline, **represents**, to all intents and purposes, **a formal renunciation** of placement in any EDiSU college.

CRITERIA BY WHICH COLLEGE PLACEMENTS ARE ASSIGNED AND HOW TO ACCEPT

For students enrolled in the “**FILTER SEMESTER**”

- ★ Acceptance of the bed spot for the first semester in the college to which he has been assigned to.
N.B. Students who enrol in the University of Pavia for the 2026/2027 a.y. within the beginning of the second semester, are allowed to stay in college until the end of the academic year.
- ★ The payment receipt, made through PagoPA, of the confirmatory deposit **250,00€**.
- ★ Acceptance of the college rules of conduct.

Failure to accept the spot and to provide proof of the 250,00€ fee payment, within the given deadline, **represents**, to all intents and purposes, **a formal renunciation** of placement in any EDiSU college.

In the event that additional places will remain available, after all applicants in the “**PRIMARY RANKING LIST**” have been allocated a place, these free bed spots can be assigned to applicants listed in the “**SUPPLEMENTARY RANKING LIST**”.

Students included in the supplementary ranking list, should they be assigned a college placement, will be required to pay an annual fee equal to that established for students in the fourth income tier.

ANNUAL RE-CONFIRMATION OF COLLEGE PLACEMENT

All College placements are assigned for one academic year and can be *confirmed year by year for the entire official duration of the course of study* only on the condition that:



the student **possesses the merit requirements indicated in Attachment A** of this notice. These requirements may also be met by using the bonus points.



the student **is on time with the payment of the College fees** relative to the academic year underway.

Example: In 2025/2026 a first-year student won a place at an EDiSU College, for his second year (a.y. 2026/2027) he DOES NOT NEED TO PARTICIPATE in the call for application again.
In order to keep his room, *he just needs to fill out the required form and submit it to the bursar of the college within the given time and measures.*

Failure to submit the re-confirmation form to the Economo represents a formal renunciation of the College spot.

The **reconfirmation request** is intended for the entire academic year, and the college fee must be entirely paid*.

*THIS PRINCIPLE CAN BE WAIVED IN 2 CASES:

- 1) For students who, in the reconfirmation form, indicate that during the a.y. 2026/2027 will attend an *international mobility program*, approved by the Pavia University, leaving the spot at the residence and clearing the room.

In this case *the college fee to pay is proportioned to the period of actual stay* at the residence.

- 2) For students enrolled, in the 2026/2027 a.y., in the “*first year over time/last semester*”, that intend to keep their college spot only for the first semester.

In this case *the college fee to pay is proportioned to the period of actual stay* at the residence.

INCOME TIERS AND ACCOMMODATION FEES

The student is required to pay a fee calculated according to three income brackets.

INCOME TIERS	ISEE VALUE
1° tier	from € 0,00 to € 13.443,97
2° tier	from € 13.443,98 to € 17.925,29
3° tier	from € 17.925,30 to € 26.887,93
Over 3° tier	Above € 26.887,92

All students, except for the "particular cases", must pay the annual fee in 3 instalments:

- the first instalment of **€800,00** to be paid by *December 31, 2026*;
- the second instalment to be paid at the latest by *March 31, 2027*;
- the third instalment to be paid at the latest by *June 30, 2027*.

Failure to pay the first instalment involves the **revocation of the college spot**, along with the deduction of any amount paid, the payment of a fine and the clearing out of the room within one (n. 1) month from the receipt of the "annulment decree/ decreto di revoca allo studente" (at the student's University e-mail address).

PARTICULAR CASES

- ★ Students who are **scholarship beneficiaries** for the 2026/2027 academic year and who qualify as **“OFF-SITE” STUDENTS** can benefit from free college placements:
- If enrolled in years subsequent to the first, they are NOT REQUIRED to pay the 3 instalments of the college fee
 - If enrolled in the first year of all courses, they are suspended from the payment of the 3 instalments of college fee pending the achievement, **NO later than 30 November 2027**, of the number of credits stated in Attachment B of the Call for scholarship applications. Failure to achieve the number of credits required by 30 November 2027 will result in the **revocation of the scholarship** benefit and the consequent payment of the entire college fee.
- ★ Students, **beneficiaries of the scholarship as “off-site”** (“fuori sede”), who attend **INTERNATIONAL MOBILITY** programs during a.y. 2026/2027

Students staying at an EDiSU College, who have informed the Economo, **at the beginning of the academic year**, that they intend to **take part in an international mobility program during the 2026/2027** a.y. and want to free their spot at the college room, if awarded the scholarship for the 2026/2027 academic year as “off-site” students **will receive the entire scholarship amount without the deduction for the college fee**.

These students will be personally in charge of paying for the period of time in which they actually use their lodging.

- ★ Students, **beneficiaries of the scholarship as “off-site”** (“fuori sede”), enrolled as **“ONE-YEAR OVER REGULAR TIME”** in the a.y. 2026/2027
- Students staying at an EDiSU College who have informed the Economo that they want to keep the college spot **ONLY** for the **FIRST SEMESTER**, **DO NOT** need to pay the first instalment.
 - *All other students* staying at an EDiSU College, who have **NOT informed the Economo** that they wanted to keep the college spot only for the first semester, **HAVE TO pay both the first instalment and the second instalment** calculated “as balance” of the annual fee.

- ★ Students enrolled in the **“FILTER SEMESTER”**

Students enrolled in the “filter semester” of the Medicine and Surgery course or Dentistry and Dental Prosthodontics course, who are staying at an EDiSU College, need to **pay a FLAT-RATE FEE of 1.470,00 €**.

Payments must be made as follows: 1) **first instalment of 50% at the entrance** 2) **second instalment of the other 50%** before November 30, 2026.

These students, who will enroll at Pavia University during the second semester of the a.y. 2026/2027, **can keep their college spot** and will have to pay the annual fee according to their income tier, minus the amount already paid during the filter semester.

RENOUNCING COLLEGE PLACEMENT

- Students who decide for personal reasons to renounce their college accommodation by November 16, 2026, are required to pay for the period of time actually spent at the college and the deposit **WILL NOT BE REFUNDED**. The deposit will be refunded in the case of students who leave the college because of serious and proved health issues.
- Students who decide to give an allocated place in college after November 16, 2026, ARE REQUIRED TO PAY the entire fee for the 2026/2027 academic year.

All students who *renounce their assigned college spot* in 2026/2027 a.y., **will not be able to access any EDiSU college** in the same academic year.

POSTGRADUATE PLACEMENTS

Each College in Pavia (where all courses in medicine and surgery are held) **reserves placements for postgraduate students in the medical field**. Application **must be presented to the Dean of the College** in which the student intends to request a postgraduate placement. Placements will be assigned taking into consideration *the status of former student, his/her final mark, and the financial status of his/her family unit*.

RESERVED COLLEGE PLACEMENTS

For the academic year 2026/2027 EDiSU has **reserved n. 50 places for female students enrolled in STEM** (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) degree courses.

OPERATING PERIOD

The management of the administrative and practical duties is carried out by a **Bursar (ECONOMO)**.

In the 2026/2027 academic year, college accommodation **starts on September 14, 2026, and ends on July 28, 2026**.

For the **2026 Christmas holiday period**, students who cannot leave Pavia can ask to remain at their college by submitting a duly substantiated request that **must be presented by November 13, 2026**, to the Bursar of their college.

For the period of the **2027 summer holidays**, students/guests of the colleges located in Pavia who are unable to leave the university premises may request to remain in college by presenting a suitably motivated request **by 15 June 2027** to the Bursar of their college.

Accommodation for the summer period **will be offered at Golgi college** or at other designated facility upon payment of the flat-rate, **non-fractional fee of €300,00** (it is not possible to stay, in August, for fractions of a month but only for the whole month).

Students meeting the requirements for confirming their placement for the following academic year, who have proven their **necessity to stay** in College **since the first days of September 2026**, are required to submit a request to the Bursar of their college **by July 17, 2026**.
